New York Philharmonic Lectures by Joelle Wallach
Precede Performances of Music of Beethoven and
Hartmann on March 15, 16, 17 and 20

Composer Joelle Wallach will be giving New York Philharmonic Pre-Concert Lectures in the Helen Huntington Hull Room of Lincoln Center's Avery Fisher Hall, 10 Lincoln Center Plaza on Thursday, March 15 at 6:30 PM, Friday, March 16 at 10:00 AM, Saturday, March 17 at 7:00 PM and Tuesday, March 20 at 6:30 PM.

The subject of these lectures will be **Beethoven and Hartmann - Heroic Responses to Tyranny**. They will precede performances of Beethoven's Symphonies 1 and 3 and Karl Amadeus Hartmann's *Concerto funèbre* for Solo Violin and String Orchestra, with soloist Gil Shaham. The performances will be conducted by David Zinman.
