Composer Joelle Wallach will be giving New York Philharmonic Pre-Concert Lectures in the Helen Huntington Hull Room of Lincoln Center's Avery Fisher Hall, 10 Lincoln Center Plaza on Wednesday, June 20 at 6:30 PM, Thursday, June 21 at 6:30 PM, Friday, June 22 at 7:00 PM and Saturday, June 23 at 7:00 PM.

The subject of these lectures will be **The Mature Mozart**. They will precede performances of his **Piano Concerto No. 22** with soloist Emanuel Ax, and **Mass in C minor, Great**, conducted by Alan Gilbert.
