Joelle Wallach's **The Wreath of Silver Birds** will be performed by 2Flutes - Pamela Sklar and Laura Falzon on Wednesday, October 22 - 1:00 PM at St. Paul's Church National Historic Site, 897 South Columbus Avenue in Mt. Vernon, New York.

The composer writes, "**The Wreath of Silver Birds** was written in 1995 as an outdoor work for solo piccolo in honor of the 95th birthday of composer Otto Luening, on the occasion of the inauguration of the
